Arrival and Parking

Address of the Jamstival (Village community center Bringhausen):

Fünfseenblick-Str. 2, 34122 Edertal - Bringhausen

You can park at the Bringhausen public car park and along the surrounding streets. The courtyard of the village community center can be used for loading and unloading and only after consultation for parking. The Bringhausen guest house across the street also has a few parking spaces available for those who stay there.

Jamstival Venue

Indoor: In addition to a large hall and a small hall in the village community center, there is also a spacious, covered extension. The guest house opposite also has a lounge that can be used in bad weather.

Outdoor: if the weather is hopefully good, we can also use the meadow next to the extension as well as the paved inner courtyard between the village community center and the extension. Please don't forget camping chairs. In the appendix you will find an overview map.

Our "Reception"

Upon arrival, please report to our reception on site or to a member of the organization if this is not occupied at the moment.

Accomodation

Accommodation is to be organized by everyone. If you are staying at the Bringhausen guest house (owner Lars Kreh), you can receive the keys at our Jamstival reception upon arrival and pay any outstanding accommodation fees. Please bring the money for this in cash if possible!

For overnight stays in a camper / tent there may be areas on the site and at Rolf and Andrea's. Please inquire beforehand. Otherwise, the nearby campsites in Bringhausen are also recommended (see appendix).

Meals

As already announced, self-sufficiency applies. A kitchen is available for this purpose in the main building, which will be open to all participants at fixed times. In between, only the organizing team has access. Refrigerators are available.

A communal kitchen is also available in the Bringhausen guest house. This can be used by the guests there.

A list of other options for catering and refreshments can be found in the appendix. Grill and charcoal will also be available and can be used by everyone.

Beverages

A certain contingent of mineral water, beer and alcohol-free beer is available on site at reasonable prices. Coffee and tea are included in the festival price. Of course, you can also take care of your own drinks. As in the previous year, surpluses from the drinks register go to a charitable purpose.

Care of Health

The organizers will only implement the valid rules of the federal state of Hesse and ensure general basic hygiene on site.

We ask everyone who is aware of an infectious disease (e.g. Covid-19) to refrain from participating or to take measures not to endanger other people during this festival weekend.

Barter Market

If you have little things like instruments, straps, strings, sheet music or other accessories that are no longer needed but could still be useful to others, you are welcome to bring them with you and put them in the exchange box. All participants can use it. Also those who want to get rid of an instrument at a fair price have the opportunity to advertise it here.

We look forward to seeing you and lots of music at the Edersee!


